



SNOWY MOUNTAINS & ANZAC MEMORIAL TOUR 2017

Day One Sunday 23rd April 2017

Our Coach will meet you at Eddy Avenue, Central Station or at Everton Road, Strathfield Station. We stop for lunch along the way (own expense) and then continue travelling along the Hume Highway before passing through Canberra and heading south to Cooma. Your first delicious dinner is in our beautiful Top of the Town restaurant, which has outstanding views over Cooma and surrounding countryside.

Day Two Monday 24th April 2017

Today we travel to the picturesque town of Bombala with its diverse natural environment - treeless plains, rolling pastures and dense native forests intersected by a network of rivers and streams. Here we will see the Collectables Museum, the historic machinery and engine shed and Lavender House with fascinating range of lavender and lavender products. We return to the motel for another delicious meal.



Day Three Anzac Day Tuesday 25th April 2017

An early start. This will allow us to travel the Monaro Highway to Canberra to participate in the National ANZAC Service at the War Memorial. The service will be televised across the nation and will be attended by the Prime Minister and around 20,000 people. The service is around 45 minutes long and features parades and flybys by our defence forces. We have special reserved seating with an excellent view of all proceedings. We need to be there and in place well before the 10.30am service. After the service you can visit the Memorial and Wall of Honour or other icons in Canberra.



Day Four **Wednesday 26th April 2017**

Town tour of Cooma including a visit to the historic Cooma Railway Station, the second busiest station in NSW during the snowy days. Then it's off to Cooma Gaol and a fabulous insight into penal history at the Gaol Museum. We go back to the motel for a delicious lunch. In the afternoon we visit the Snowy Hydro exhibition and see the audio-visual about the Snowy Mountains Scheme. After that, enjoy free time at the Cooma Centennial Park to check out the avenue of flags and the mosaic time-walk.



Day Five **Thursday 27th April 2017**

We head towards the mountains in the hope of good visibility and the chance to see Mount Kosciuszko, Australia's highest peak so named by a Pole, after a fellow Pole. Today is a day of more learning of Australia's history, stories and legends, tall tales and true. A day of majestic beauty and wonder as we travel the roads of pioneers and multiculturalism as the great snowy scheme was achieved. We venture up to Perisher and then on to Charlotte Adam's famous pass to view Mount Kosciuszko before going of Thredbo. A big day with morning tea and a picnic lunch, before heading back to Cooma.

Day Six **Friday 27th April 2017**

We enjoy breakfast in the morning then commence our journey home after saying goodbye to the friendly staff at the Motel.
